REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

The Trustees present their report & financial statements for the period 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019

CHARITABLE OBJECTIVES

The Trustees agreed to extend the objectives to include running activities to benefit young people following Wiltshire Council decision to close all youth centres across the county. Approval was granted by the Charity Commission & a revised deed issued on 11th October 2014

The charitable objectives are now as follows :

*To act as a resource for young people to the age 13-25 (with trustee discretion to extend over the 25 age) living in the UK by providing grants of money as a means of :

- a. Advancing in life & helping young people develop their skills
- b. Advancing education
- c. Relieving unemployment

*The relief of financial hardship, either general or individual of young people age 13-25 by making grants of money

*To organise activities/projects for the benefit of young people that provide opportunities for them to advance in life by developing their personal & social skills & capabilities, so as to fulfil their artistic, moral & social potential & enable them to participate in society

PRINCIPLE ACTIVITY

The principle activities of the Trust are raising funds & awarding grants to young people in line with the charitable objectives :

GOVERNANCE

The Trust is a registered charity & is recognised by HMRC as a charity for tax. The Trust is governed by a Trust Deed dated 11th October 2014

FUNDRAISING & INCOME

In the period, a total income of £9,563.05 was achieved. The principle sources of funds in the period were :

PROJECT FUNDS


